**Traditional combination Weed and Feed** is no longer available as of January, 2010 due to government regulations. While similar products are still offered in separate forms, fertilizer alone or pesticide alone, we now carry Sarritor as a replacement for the former combined product.

#### Sarritor - Biological Lawn Weed Killer

- Fast acting and effective non-chemical weed control

- Controls dandelions and does not harm the lawn

### When Designing Your Yard....

### Things to Remember:

- Keep it simple
- Keep materials and designs similar to the house style
- Keep it functional
- Use repetition of plant material in order to keep harmony and unity in your yard
- Use mulches and fabrics where possible to reduce weeds
- Remember to design for all four seasons
- Entry walks should be approximately 4.5' wide for ease of two people walking side by side
- A deck should be a recommended minimum of 12' x 12' to accommodate a table and four chairs

#### Questions to Ask Your Landscape Designer:

- Do you want outdoor lighting?
- Do you want a water feature?
- Do you want an outdoor kitchen?
- Do you have enough soil?
- Do you have enough storage space?
- Do you need/have access for large equipment?

#### **Most Important:**

- Check with the city/county for any bylaws, setbacks or restrictions
- Be sure to have any needed permits

All registrants must pre-register. Limit is 15 people so sign up early


