Did You Know...

Let your poinsettias dry substantially between watering it. They don't like "wet feet". Poinsettias are non-toxic and perfectly safe for children or pets to touch.

Sugar, Aspirin, or Seven Up added to water will **not** make cut flowers and Christmas trees or Christmas greens last longer. We recommend the use of good clean water changed regularly with proper cut flower food dissolved in it. Cut flower food is available in our garden centre. Keeping your Christmas tree or greens in a cool, humid place also helps. Antidessicants such as WiltProof, sprayed on the foliage also helps.

Cut evergreen boughs can be arranged in your summer planters in mid November. If kept in a cold, shady location, they will keep until well after Christmas. Direct sunlight and warm temperatures will cause browning earlier.

Success with Christmas Cactus (Zygocactus)...

Christmas Cactus is one of the tropical cacti; not desert cacti. That means that they will not withstand colder temperatures and that they are not drought tolerant as are the desert cacti. They are grown in regular houseplant potting mix, in a pot with good drainage. They require full sun in winter months but need partial shade in summer. Allow only slight drying between watering and never overwater. To induce flowering, provide slightly cooler temperatures at night and shorter days from September on. A flowering plant fertilizer such as Plant Prod 15-30-15 or 15-15-18 will also help to encourage flowering.

Fresh Cut Christmas Trees...*Arriving late November; To order call 403.346.5613*

1. Fraser Fir - beautiful blue colored, sheared for a pyramidal shape; great fragrance
2. Balsam Fir – sheared pyramidal shape, dark green foliage, very fragrant
3. Scotch Pine – rich, long needled, excellent fragrance
4. Larger trees up to 12ft.

How to Care for Fresh Cut Trees...

1. No matter what was done at the tree lot, cut a couple of inches off the bottom of your fresh Christmas tree immediately before you put it in the stand. The process of sap blocking the water uptake system of a natural Christmas tree starts as soon as it is cut and begins to warm up. It is worth your while to put the effort into cutting off the bottom when you get home.
2. Fraser fir is considered the longest lasting of the real Christmas trees available here. No matter how fresh they start out, and no matter how much water you get them to take up, well-cared-for, your Fraser should last up to four weeks.
3. You cannot over-water your cut Christmas tree. A seven-foot tree should take up a good litre of water per day in the first week indoors.
4. Real Christmas trees are rarely the cause of allergy attacks. They do not give off pollen. More likely culprits are the old decorations unpacked to put on the tree, the old tree stand and water that doesn't get taken up by the tree. If you have an artificial tree, the dust and mould it collects over the years may cause allergy attacks as well.
5. You should not chop up your Christmas tree for the fireplace in January. Sappy softwoods contribute to creosote build-up in your chimney. Instead, stand it outside by the bird feeders, the birds will love it.

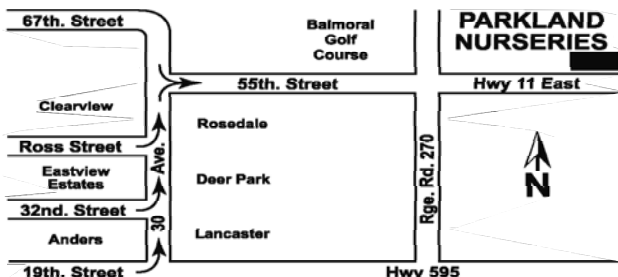
